Material includes photographs, transcripts and recordings of speeches delivered during the department’s annual events, which attracted well-known Civil Rights activists including Thurgood Marshall and Martin Luther King, Jr.
- [***Socialism on Film: The Cold War and International Propaganda***](#), sourced from the British Film Institute (BFI), is a collection of documentary, newsreel and feature films revealing the world as seen by Soviet, Chinese, Vietnamese, East European, and Latin American filmmakers. Ranging from the early 20th century to the 1980s, material encapsulates the themes of war, revolution, news, current affairs, culture and society.
- [***Trade Catalogues and the American Home***](#) reveals domestic consumerism, life and leisure in nineteenth and early-twentieth century America. Highly illustrated, the collection is a valuable visual record of the products documenting the lifestyle of the American consumer, facilitating teaching and research into popular culture, material culture, and societal changes, as well as the history of marketing, business, and technology.
- [***Medical Services and Warfare***](#) presents military, scientific, professional and personal perspectives on medicine during conflicts across North America and Europe from the mid-nineteenth century onwards. Highlights include the personal correspondence of Florence Nightingale, diaries of VADs, hospital records and literature from the Red Cross.
